PHASE ONE

- SCVDA Opens
- Facilities are cleaned & prepared to safely serve our dancers and families.
- Staff discussions about safely returning to teaching.
- SCVDA Preparedness Plan implemented & communicated.
- 2020-2021 Dance Schedule created and communicated.
- Continue to monitor new information as it is presented by the CDC and shift plan if needed.

PHASE TWO

- Continue Phase one protocols.
- In-person dance classes begin with safety precautions.
- Virtual dance offerings as requested.
- Continue to monitor new information as it is presented by the CDC and shift plan if needed.

PHASE THREE

- Restrictions are loosened.
- Class and building restrictions to be evaluated and re-assessed as recommended.
- Continue to monitor new information as it is presented by the CDC and shift plan if needed.

STAFF GUIDELINES

- Staff will self-monitor for any COVID-19 related symptoms and stay home if a fever of 100.4 has been detected within the past 72 hours.
- Staff will wash hands often and sanitize before, during and after each class.
- All Staff will wear masks/PPE until restrictions are loosened.
- · Staff will have very limited contact with students.
- Staff will encourage social distancing as needed.

DANCER & FAMILY GUIDELINES

- Dancers and families should self-monitor and remain home if experiencing any fevers of 100.4 or greater within the past 72 hours and/or if experiencing any Covid-19 related symptoms.
- Dancers should be dropped off by the front entrance. Parents can
 walk students to the front door if needed. We will have staff at the
 front entrance to assist our dancers.
- We are asking that parents/siblings do not wait in our waiting rooms/common areas unless absolutely necessary. We realize that parents of our younger classes may need to stay during their child's class time on occasion.
- If parents/siblings (over age 5) enter our building we ask that you kindly wear a mask.
- Dancers will be encouraged to wash their hands and utilize our hand sanitizing stations placed throughout the studio.
- All dancers over the age of 5 must wear a mask while in our building. Most of our classes do not require intense aerobic activity and will therefore, be safe for our students.

FACILITY GUIDELINES

- All dancers will be asked to enter using the front entrance. We will have staff at the front door to assist dancers to their classrooms.
- All older dancers in Baldwin will be asked to exit using our back door to assist us with the traffic flow within the studio.
- Younger dancers will be brought to the front door at the end of class and a parent will need to pick them up there.
- Classes will receive further emails regarding drop off and pick up procedures.
- 6 foot squares will be taped off within each studio and we will strive to keep our students safely distanced.
- Our water fountain in Baldwin will be closed. You will still be able
 to use the water bottle filler, so please plan to bring your own
 water bottle labeled with your name at both of our locations.

FACILITY READINESS

- Both Baldwin and Roberts have been equipped with HVAC Upgrades.
- Sanitizing stations will be placed at each studio location.
- Electrostatic sprayers will be used to clean highly used surfaces.
- High contact areas will be sanitized regularly.
- Seating areas will be limited to allow for a 6 foot distance.
- Daily sanitizing of bathrooms and dance floors.
